WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING AT CCCC

April 10, April 13, CCCC and CCACC donated protective gowns, eye shields, facial shields and masks to Atrium Health and Novant Health



April 10, Shanghai Longda Plastic Tech Ltd, a member company, donated 10,000 surgical masks to CCCC.

April 19, CCCC members (Crown Park Gold Club, 360 Healthcare, Chinaberry Tree Linens, and Jen Ridgway, among others) in Myrtle Beach donated PPEs to Tidelands Health
